Visual Aid Guide

As part of your Lab B, as well as Lab C and D assignments, you will need to produce a visual aid. The visual aid you create should be clear and to the point. The visual aid you create needs to have the following characteristics:

- Use a standard sized poster board. You can also use a similarly sized foam board.
- The lettering should be neat. Consider using punch-out lettering or letter stencils.
- You should be able to view the content from 30 feet away.
- The visual aid should be neat visually, without spelling errors.
- You should use color if possible, trying to use colors or "add-ons" that draw the reader's attention.
- Keep it simple, a few cues words or phrases should suffice. You can use an acronym/Mnemonic. What you create should convey the concept/points of the skill you are teaching clearly.
