

EXS 297 Motor Behavior Lab – 4/4-4/5 Project Work

When not performing on the rotary pursuit today, work on the following:

- I. **Review the project handout** carefully as a group so that you all fully understand what is expected of you for the manual/guide and also what you will need to be doing between now and the day of the Game Show.

- II. **Share your concept application** with your group and if you have not already done so, combine all the information into a coherent learning experience for your contestants. Keep in mind that there will be a 5th game on the day of the game show that you will not know about. Think about how you can be best prepared for that.

- III. **Review your group's ability assessment results** to make sure that you have assigned group members to the games. You should also have a back up person for each game, just in case something unforeseen happens the day of the game show and your star contestant is no there to compete!

- IV. **Discuss how you will be assessing the learning** of your contestants for that portion of your report.

- V. **Organizing group** – Review the equipment needed for your games. Next week you will need to have the equipment in lab so that the groups can begin to practice the games. Try to provide a sufficient amount of the equipment so more than 1 person can be practicing at a time.
