

EXS 297 Motor Behavior Lab – 4/11-4/12
Project Work

- I. Organizing group – Explain and demonstrate each of the 4 games.

- II. a. Begin to **implement your designed learning experience** for much of the remainder of lab by assessing and/or preparing the contestants for the game show on April 25-26.

b. Organizing group – spend some time talking about the day of the game show. How will that day be organized? Will you have one MC or multiple? How do you want the lab arranged? Who will be timing (I suggest always use 2 timers)?

- III. **Discuss** with your group how the contestants need to be practicing during the next two weeks. **How** will they need to be practicing? How will you be monitoring that?

- IV. **If time permits**, you may wish to **discuss** who will be responsible for doing what for the guide/manual. Divide up the tasks. Who will be responsible for collecting and compiling all the content to see that it is in the same format, etc.? Who will be writing up the assessment section? Is someone else going to be responsible for compiling the references (if you have any)? How about the images and/or graphics (be sure to make note of the sources if you include these)?

- V. **Review how you will be assessing the learning** of your contestants for that portion of your report. Think about how you will be monitoring practice. This should be included in your manual as well.

For the next lab (4/18-19):

- Nothing is officially due; each group should be working on putting together their manual AND continuing to implement the learning experience by having group members practice the games the way you have designed it to be practiced.
- Part of lab will be devoted to continuing to assess and implement your learning experience.
